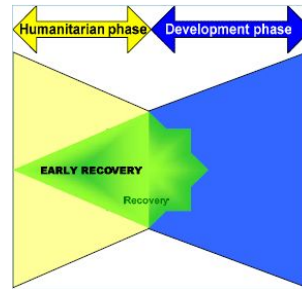

INTEGRATED DISASTER REDUCTION APPROACH
